

# FIVE POINT STAR OF ACHIEVEMENT---CLUB AWARD

(Since 1931)

The Five Point Star of Achievement Certificate is awarded at the close of each two year term to the Club which best fulfills the standard symbolized by the star and its five points. Each District conducts a contest and the winner of the District Award is entered in the State Competition. Star of Achievement Chairman is the State President-Elect.

## ENTRY FORM

The five points symbolized in the "Star of Achievement" biennial contest, GFWC of Arkansas, are as follows. Check next to each point if your club has attained that point

1. All club dues and special assessments paid on time.
2. Two years' club program based on GFWC departments of work.
3. Minimum of ten percent (10%) of club members subscribing to *GFWC Clubwoman*
4. All members of the club are registered voters and tax payers.
5. Club has as a definite goal of outstanding achievement for community betterment.

## RULES

1. The Chairman of the Five Point Star of Achievement Contest shall be a member of the GFWC-AR Executive Committee, members of her committee being named by the District Presidents.
2. Clubs entering the contest may use up to ten sheets of paper, double-spaced, to describe the three areas as listed in "Grading of Project." This ten-page entry may include newspaper clippings and photographs and may be bound in a lightweight folder.
3. District Star of Achievement Contest Chairman shall receive the completed form above at least 21 days prior to the District Convention along with description as noted in #2.
4. The District Club Rating Summaries shall accompany the winning entry from each District and shall be forwarded to the State Contest Chairman immediately after the District Spring Convention.
5. Recognition for club achievement must apply to the current two-year program.
6. Awards and recognition will be made at the District and State Conventions held at the close of the two-year term.
