Officers of the State Federation Executive Committee and District Presidents are not eligible to participate in the contest. Nomination must cover work done by the nominee for one year (January 1 to December 31)

Describe in detail how nominee's club and community have benefited because she is an active and progressive member of each (25 points)

Narrative must be double spaced, using one side of the paper only and must not exceed six pages. Entry should not exceed ten pages in all. This ten-page entry may include newspaper clippings and photographs and may be bound in a lightweight folder. Send entries to District Chairman at least 21 days prior to District Convention. District Chairman shall send winner to GFWC-AR President-elect, who will award the winner with a plaque at the State Spring Convention.
